







Programmatic Diagrams




Diagram 1

- gently terrace corner of nason/summer st into a more defined performance space
- expand existing memorial area
- create clearer pathways along edges of park
- integrate sensory/musical play elements




Diagram 2a

- push performance and memorial spaces towards the “basin”
- relocate memorial with possibly a more linear configuration
- define corner of nason/summer st with sculpture/art piece
- activate unused spaces with more defined seating, pathways, and passive play experiences.




Diagram 2b

- activate unused spaces with more defined seating, pathways, and passive play experiences.





Diagram 3
