## **ADMINISTRATION**

- Town Administrator (TA) Johnson and Assistant Town Administrator (ATA) Stephanie Duggan are conducting regular collective bargaining agreement negotiations with the IAFF Fire Fighters Local 1947 union, and have commenced negotiations with the Public Safety Tele-Communicators NEPBA Local 114 dispatchers union.

- Town Clerk Dianne Reardon submitted the town by-law changes approved at the recent Town Meeting to the state's Attorney General Office for review and approval.
