ADMINISTRATION

- Town Administrator Johnson and Assistant Town Administrator (ATA) Stephanie Duggan thank all the town staff for supporting and participating in the annual(ish) Thanksgiving Breakfast, hosted at Town Hall on Tuesday, November 25, 2025.
- Town offices will be closed:
 - Annual Holiday party for town staff: Tuesday, December 16th, from 11am to 1pm.
 - Christmas: Noon (12pm) on Wednesday, December 24, thru Friday, December 26, 2025.
 - New Years: Thursday, January 1, and Friday, January 2, 2025.
- TA Johnson and ATA Duggan continue negotiations with LIUNA Professionals and LIUNA Laborers (DPW), and have begun negotiations with AFSCME Clerical and NEPBA Police Patrolmen and Superiors.
- TA Johnson received general contractor bids in procurement of services to repair the east stair well of the Maynard Library. The Library Director and TA Office are working with design firm Liro-Hill to progress on long-planned repairs to the facility.
