

RESOURCES TO WATCH OUT FOR

"It is important to be aware of Fake Women's Health Centers that present themselves as resources for women facing unplanned pregnancies.

Fake Women's Health Centers are typically managed and funded by organizations that oppose abortion in any and all circumstances.

While these facilities may offer free pregnancy testing, they are purposefully vague about whether they provide abortion care.

Some may be licensed to provide medical care; even so, they exist to dissuade women from receiving abortion care. They may not have any medical professionals available to speak with their clients.

They tend to "counsel" a pregnant woman by engaging in a lengthy discussion about fetal development, providing misinformation about the alleged "dangers" of abortion, and pressuring the individual to choose parenthood or adoption."

LEGALITY IN MASSACHUSETTS

*Surgical and medication abortions are **legal** in the state of Massachusetts. Governor Baker signed executive order No. 600 on June 24, 2022 further protecting access to reproductive health care services in Massachusetts. This executive order protects out of state individuals seeking abortions in Massachusetts and those that help them.*
